Mon 28 July: **Starting qualitative research** – workshops on introduction to qualitative research, introduction to narrative research.

Tue 29 July: **Collecting qualitative data** – workshops on qualitative interviewing, focus groups, textual data collection.

Wed 30-Thur 31 July: **Analysing qualitative data** – workshops on Interpretative Phenomenological Analysis, Conversation Analysis, Discursive Psychology, Thematic Analysis 2-day 'Master Class'.

Friday 1 August: **Finishing qualitative research** – workshops on communicating qualitative research, quality and rigor in qualitative research.
