As an active supporter of our university, we invite you to help us spread the word about the opportunity CEU provides to obtain a world-class graduate education in a diverse, international community committed to open debate and inquiry, driven by cutting-edge research into the pressing issues of our time. We believe that the path to a resolution is clear – the Hungarian government negotiated an agreement with the State of New York that would enable us to remain in Budapest, and CEU signed an agreement with Bard College that enables us to comply with lex CEU by launching academic programs in the U.S. The government need only sign the agreement and ratify it in Parliament. In the meantime, a recent extension of the deadline for compliance with lex CEU enables us to recruit students for fall 2018 with absolute confidence.
