

Call for Unpublished Work

Hi all-

Our research team (including Professor Elke Weber and Dr. Gregg Sparkman) is currently conducting a meta-analysis to understand the effects of social norms manipulations.

We have conducted a comprehensive literature review (from an original 14,000 articles on norms!) and are now seeking unpublished works on this topic. We are looking for unpublished empirical research (e.g., in-press and conference papers, dissertations, master theses, unpublished manuscripts, white papers or self-published work, etc.) which satisfy the following criteria:

- 1) Empirical studies reporting outcomes of manipulating norm perceptions
- 2) The experimental study must include a comparison condition as a suitable control group (e.g. a neutral task, no task, an active control designed to control for demand, etc.).
- 3) Outcome measures must be related to conformity (e.g. a related behavior or attitude to the norm communicated).

Any unpublished work would be very helpful for conducting our meta-analysis.
