Profile

- Doctorate in psychology or equivalent;
- Good academic teaching record;
- Methodological expertise (in quantitative, qualitative and/or combined methods) in the development, adaptation and evaluation of intercultural psychological interventions;
- Proven research record in the context of individual and/or group interventions in intercultural psychology in educational, institutional, community or family environments;
- Excellent international networks;
- Clinical experience in intercultural psychology required;
- Expertise in a wide range of qualitative, quantitative and mixed research methods would be an advantage.

Teaching (45%)

Six hours of teaching a week, throughout the year, at Bachelor (BA) and Master (MA) levels, determined in accordance with institutional requirements, including:

- Introductory lecture course in intercultural clinical psychology (BA level lecture, 28 hours, 3 ECTS)
- Seminar in research design and methods (BA level seminar, 56 hours, annual, 6 ECTS)
- Lecture course in intercultural clinical psychology, precise topic to be determined according to the candidate's area of expertise (MA course, 56 hours, 6 ECTS).
- Seminar in intercultural clinical psychology; precise topic to be determined according to the candidate's area of expertise (MA seminar, 28 hours, 3 ECTS)

Supervision of MA dissertations and PhD theses.



Research (45%)

The post-holder will pursue research in intercultural clinical psychology, in the development, adaptation and evaluation of intercultural psychological interventions. The post-holder will be affiliated to one of the research centres in the Institute of Psychology (IP). S/he will be expected to produce high-quality academic publications.

S/he will seek external funding, in particular from the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF).

Administrative responsibilities (10%)

In accordance with statutory requirements and in the name of collegiality, the post-holder will take on any administrative tasks that may be assigned to them by the Institute, Faculty, University or university decision-making bodies. The post-holder will contribute to the development of consultations at the Institute of Psychology.

Institutional environment

The post is located in the Institute of Psychology (IP) and the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences.

Starting date: 1st August 2020

Candidates are invited to submit their application in PDF format **via the online recruitment system** containing a cover letter, academic CV (**including list of publications**), copies of diplomas and qualifications and five main publications. Only applications submitted via the online system will be considered.
